## FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

**Should I fill out a Rejoice! commitment card?** Yes, you will be receiving one in the mail. Commitments can be mailed, emailed (parishadmin@holyltrinitysr.org), or placed in the Sunday collection plate.

**How long do I have to meet my Rejoice! commitment?** Committed funds are due by the end of 2022. That being said, the sooner commitments have been paid in full, the less impact the campaign will have on the church's endowment fund.

**When are the Rejoice! commitment cards due?** Commitments and contributions are welcome at any time, and the campaign will remain open until the funds are raised. However, for planning purposes we hope that as many commitments as possible will be returned for the ingathering blessing on June 27, 2021.

**Is there a guideline of how much to commit?** We want you to pray about your gift and then be comfortable with your decision. (Some outside sources indicate that a commitment should be two times your annual operating pledge, payable over two years.)

***As a congregation, we have been particularly blessed by the households that have already stepped up in faith to support our Restore, Renew, Rejoice! campaign. Our Leadership Gifts total \$60,766. We will need \$49,234 to reach our goal. We are seeking 100% participation, no gift is too small.***
